

6th Grade Social Studies Avenues of Hope Overview

Your student has been assigned an academic intervention on their Student Academic Accountability Plan to address learning deficits and encourage mastery of important standards. Please review all the intervention requirements below and direct any questions to your subject teacher. Failure to complete the assigned intervention as outlined below will result in entrance into or violation of the Academic Probation Program.

Intervention Overview:

Purpose:

Avenues of Hope (AOH) is a six week credit recovery program for students who failed a core course during Semester A. Successful completion of AOH earns students promotion credit for Semester A.

Requirements:

Students must attend required LiveLessons on the Planner, complete Evidence of Learning assignments within the required LiveLessons, and complete their weekly AOH Homework Assignment. In order to earn promotion credit, students must earn at least a 70% on all AOH Homework.

Exit Plan for Intervention:

This intervention will end on March 14 .

Pathway to Mastery & Exit Plan:

1. Attend required LiveLessons each week
2. Complete and submit Evidence of Learning during LiveLesson
3. Complete AOH Homework (due each Saturday by 11:59pm)
